Entry fees: \$30.00/class except where noted. Office fee is \$30. No refunds after closing date.

Classes

- All current dressage tests offered from Introductory to Grand Prix plus equitation and suitability
- All 2022 USEF Western Dressage tests offered from introductory to Level 5*
- Divisions for all classes except rail, and in-hand include: Junior, Amateur, Open

Awards (all awards must be picked up by the end of the show)

- Ribbons to 6th place in all classes and divisions.
- Series awards covering all 4 shows. 5 scores (from any/all of the four scheduled shows) are required to earn a series award. The top 5 scores will be used to calculate a median. Any additional scores at the level will be dropped. Prize plus ribbon in all levels (dressage Intro through FEI and Western Dressage intro through level 5) and all divisions (amateur, open, junior)

Arena Size: Show arena will be covered. Outdoor warmup for long arena rides. Covered warmup for short arena rides. Short arena for: Dressage Intro, WD Intro and Basic. All other tests will be in the long arena.

Concessions: No food service is available. Please plan accordingly.

Stabling: Limited stalls available on a first come – first served basis. Stall have doors and include initial bedding. Cost is \$50.

Rules:

- USEF rules will be generally followed. www.usef.org.
- Leg protection is allowed. Auxiliary equipment or lead horses are also allowed.
- All horses must have a negative Coggins report with the original to be presented at the office.
- All dogs must be on a 6' or shorter leash and attached to a responsible adult at all times. They must be quiet.
- Emergency contact information is required on the entry form for all participants.
- Anyone riding or assisting in any way, must sign a release before handling or mounting a horse and must follow all rules of safety including wearing proper ASTM/SEI approved helmets and boots with heels.
- Show management reserves the right to change ride times when deemed necessary to facilitate timely completion of the show. No refunds after closing date. All no-show entries will be charged to the rider.
