Entry fees: \$25.00 except where noted. No refunds after closing date. Shows incur many costs. Bundle price of \$65 includes 2 tests and the office fee. Additional tests are offered at the standard price.

Classes

- All current dressage tests offered from Introductory to Grand Prix plus equitation and suitability
- All USEF Western Dressage tests offered from introductory to Level 4
- Divisions for all classes except rail, WE, and in-hand include: Junior (16 and under), young rider (17-21), Amateur, Open

Awards (all awards must be picked up by the end of the show)

- Ribbons to 6th place in all classes and divisions.
- One high point ribbon per level. No divisions.
- CPDS Year-end awards program. (See <http://www.horseshowconsulting.com> for year-end awards rules.)

Central Plains Regional Schooling Show Championship Program (October 23, 2021)

- Qualifying: The Central Plains Schooling Show Championship and Open show is November 2. You must be a member of CPDS or KDEA (or pay the \$25 non member fee) to ride in a championship class. Rider/horse team qualify with two scores of 58% or higher at a CPDS.
- Awards: Neck ribbon and prize for 1st place. Rosettes to 6th place. Prize for 1st place.
- Divisions for all levels are: Open, Junior, YR, and Amateur
 Dressage Levels offered: Sport Horse in Hand, Introductory-Grand Prix, Musical Freestyle
 Western Dressage Levels offered: Introductory through Level 4; Musical Freestyle

Arena Size: The 20 x 40 arena may be used when appropriate if show is large.

Concessions: Food and beverages available for purchase at a nominal price.

Stabling: Not available.

Rules:

- USEF rules will be generally followed. www.usef.org.
- Leg protection is allowed. Auxiliary equipment or lead horses are also allowed but *will not be placed*.
- Stallions must be attended at all times and must have a stall.
- All horses must have a negative Coggins report with the original to be presented at the office.
- Safety is first in all activities. All Children age 14 and under must be supervised at all times by an adult.
- All dogs must be on a 6' or shorter leash and attached to a responsible adult at all times. They must be quiet.
- Emergency contact information is required on the entry form for all participants.
- Anyone riding or assisting in any way, must sign a release before handling or mounting a horse and must follow all rules of safety including wearing proper ASTM/SEI approved helmets and boots with heels.
- Do not tie to trees, gates or barn structure.
- Riders, owners and trainers are responsible in full for any damage to the property or facility.
- Wash areas are available but must be left clean.
- Please make sure your horses are current on vaccinations.
- Show management reserves the right to change ride times when deemed necessary to facilitate timely completion of the show. No refunds after closing date. All no-show entries will be charged to the rider.
