

CPDS Breed High Points 2023 Year End Awards

Program

New for 2023, the highest scoring horse (one ride) from the following breed options will be awarded a 2023 year-end awards high point ribbon at the Annual General Meeting and Awards Celebration tentatively scheduled for December 2, 2023.

Rules

- The rider must be a CPDS member at the time the score is earned.
- No breed papers are needed. This is an honor system
- A horse may only be registered in one division. For example, if your horse is ½ QH and ½ Friesian, pick one breed category in which to compete.
- Notify the show office as to the category that is the best fit for your horse at your first CPDS show.
- High scores will be updated after every show and posted on horseshowconsulting.com.
