Schooling: No schooling over trail obstacles. 15 minute open schooling prior to each H/J division. Fences will be set up on Saturday after the end of the western classes.

Stalls: \$50/night or \$60 for the weekend. Stall includes initial bedding and is matted with overhead fans. Specify group you want to stable with on entry. Ask all members of the group to use the same group name on the entry.

Jump out/grounds fee if not stabling: \$10

Coggins: You will be asked to show your coggins (pulled within the past 12 months) before unloading your horse.
