**Entry fees:** \$35.00/class except where noted. Office fee is \$40 and includes lunch. No refunds after closing date.

**Classes**

- All current dressage tests offered from Introductory to Grand Prix plus equitation and suitability
- All 2022 USEF Western Dressage tests offered from introductory to Level 5\*
- Winter series team challenge covering January, February and March shows
- Divisions for all classes except rail, and in-hand include: Junior, Amateur, Open

**Awards (all awards must be picked up by the end of the show)**

- Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place in all classes and divisions.
- One high point ribbon per level. No divisions.
- CPDS Year-end awards program. CPDS offers a robust year end awards program.

**Central Plains Dressage Society Schooling Show Championship Program (October 31)**

- Qualifying: The Central Plains Schooling Show Championship and Open show is October 31. You must be a member of CPDS (or pay the \$25 non member fee) to ride in a championship class. Rider/horse team qualify with two scores of 58% or higher at the level at a CPDS schooling show.
- Awards: Neck ribbon and prize for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Rosettes to 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Divisions for all levels are: Open, Junior, and Amateur

Dressage Levels offered: Sport Horse in Hand, Introductory through Grand Prix, Musical Freestyle  
 Western Dressage Levels offered: Introductory through Level 5; Musical Freestyle

**Arena Size:** Both the outside and indoor court are 20m x 60m and may be shorted to 20m x 40m. Both courts have excellent all weather footing.

**Concessions:** Food and beverages will be provided free of charge to competitors although donations are appreciated.

**Directions:** Google maps address: 5417 York Road, Stillwater Oklahoma 74074.

**Valley View Stabling:** Stalls are 10'x10' or larger with a solid door and initial bedding. Stalls Prices: \$60 (day and overnight). No straw bedding allowed. If possible, please clean your stall on departure. Any damage to the property is the responsibility of the participant. Please pick up after yourself and your animals in all of the barns and in the indoor court. Lights will be out in all barns at 8 pm, no exceptions. Please plan your schedule accordingly. The horses need their sleep!

**Lodging:** Plenty room for contained RVs but just 4 electric hookups. See hotels.com for other options.

**Vet:** Benchmark Animal Hospital. 1701 W 116th St Perkins, OK 405-547-8607 On Highway 33 near Western Road.

**Rules:**

- USEF rules will be generally followed. [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org).
- Leg protection is allowed. Auxiliary equipment or lead horses are also allowed.
- Stallions must be attended at all times and must have a stall.
- All horses must have a negative Coggins report with the original to be presented at the office.
- Safety is first in all activities. All Children age 12 and under must be supervised at all times by an adult.
- All dogs must be on a 6' or shorter leash and attached to a responsible adult at all times. They must be quiet.
- Emergency contact information is required on the entry form for all participants.
- Anyone riding or assisting in any way, must sign a release before handling or mounting a horse and must follow all rules of safety including wearing proper ASTM/SEI approved helmets and boots with heels.
- Do not tie horses to trees, gates or the barn structure. A round pen is available for lunging and brief turnout.
- Riders, owners and trainers are responsible in full for any damage to the property or facility.
- Wash rack and bathroom is available at the pavilion which is located near the trailer parking lot.
- Please make sure your horses are current on vaccinations.
- Show management reserves the right to change ride times when deemed necessary to facilitate timely completion of the show. No refunds after closing date. All no-show entries will be charged to the rider.
- Show management has the right to refuse an entry for any reason.
- **Show manager may ask any rider who creates an unsafe situation to leave the facility.**
