

## Fees and Refunds

### A. Class and Qualifying Fees

- Equitation and Materiale \$25
- Introductory through Fourth Level \$35/test
- FEI, Freestyles \$45/test
- CPDS Championship Classes (October 29) \$50/test
- Non-competing horse \$30
- Great American/USDF Qualifying \$15
- SWDC Qualifying \$13

### B. Stalling Fees

- Day Stall \$65
- Overnight Stall \$80
- Extra Shavings \$10/bag
- Grounds fee (if not stalling) \$35
- Early Arrive/Late departure \$25/stall

### C. Administrative Fees

### D. Association Fees

- USEF Drug/Medication Fee (non-competing & opportunity class horses are exempt) \$23

- CPDS Non-Member fee (only applies if entering CPDS Championship classes on Oct 29) \$25
- USDF affidavit fee (if missing USDF credentials) \$5

### A. Open Show Awards

- Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded in all classes. (No separate awards for qualifying.) There are three divisions of most tests except as noted: Open, Adult Amateur, and Junior/Young Rider.
- Scores count toward CPDS Year-end awards program. (please see [www.horseshowconsulting.com/central-plains](http://www.horseshowconsulting.com/central-plains) for complete rules.)
- High points for the following categories by level (minimum score of 58% is required. Excludes freestyles)
  - Introductory AM, JR/YR, Open
  - First AM, JR/YR, Open
  - Second AM, JR/YR, Open
  - Third Level AM, JR/YR, Open
  - Fourth Level AM, JR/YR, Open
  - FEI Level AM, JR/YR, Open

### B. CPDS Championship Recognized Show
